**Legendary American Singer/Songwriter, Musician & Actor makes a welcome return To The UK**

Grammy award winning songwriter and performer, **Kris Kristofferson**, has announced three UK dates this summer following the release of **'Please Don't Tell Me How The Story Ends: The Publishing Demos 1968-72'**.

**Kristofferson** will play two nights at **London's Cadogan Hall** on **28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> July** followed by a show at **Manchester Bridgewater Hall** on **31<sup>st</sup> July**.

It's been two years since the legendary **singer/songwriter, musician and actor** last played in the UK and this tour will see him perform tracks from his latest critically acclaimed studio album **'Closer To The Bone'** as well as his back catalogue of classic American songs including **'Me And Bobby McGee'**, **'Sunday Morning Coming Down'**, **'For The Good Times'** and **'Help Me Make It Through The Night'**.

His most recent album release **'Please Don't Tell Me How The Story Ends: The Publishing Demos 1968-72'**, is a 16 track selection of demos which has been produced with the blessing of Kristofferson. The collection is an amazing snapshot of the formative years of one of the giants of contemporary American music.



**Kristofferson's** 2010 live show takes you back to those early halcyon days when he was an artist with just his guitar and his honest, intimate arrangements.

Having recently been awarded the BMI Icon Award at the 2009 BMI Country Awards, **Kris Kristofferson** is, once again, receiving the accolades his rich musical career deserves.

His magical live show is sure to delight fans young and old.

**Kris Kristoffers's** story is fairly well known: He had a dream – along with the necessary talent & ambition – to become a songwriter. After turning down a teaching position at West Point (and abandoning a career as an Army helicopter pilot), the Rhodes Scholar hoped to get his foot in the door of the music business by taking a job as a janitor at **Columbia Records**. It wasn't long after arriving in Nashville that he was receiving armloads of acclaim and being hailed as one of America's clearest and most important voices, having penned such classics as '**Me And Bobby McGee**', '**Sunday Morning Coming Down**', '**For The Good Times**', and many others. Now **Kristofferson** has reached living legend status, but that hasn't changed or hindered his skills as an inspiring storyteller who, unselfishly, always gives a piece of himself to his listener.
